THE CHURCH AS GOD INTENDS

Scripture: **EPHESIANS 4:7-13** // Sermon: **REV EDMUND CHAN**

Introduction

1. A Young Philosopher and A Talmudic Master: “Don’t forget the Mission!”
2. The Church As God Intends Must Grasp Three Important Things About Itself as seen in Ephesians 4:13-17.

The Church Is -

A. A **REDEEMED** COMMUNITY DERIVED BY **GRACE** (vv.7-8)

“But to each one of us grace was given....” (v.7)

1. **The Church Must Grasp The Messiah’s Victory**

- Paul’s Puzzling Parenthesis (vv.9-10) - Supreme Victory Over Death!

2. **The Church Must Grasp The Messiah’s Grace**

“And He gave gifts to men.” (v.8)

3. **Focus.** Luther counsels men to answer all temptations of Satan with this only, *“Christianus sum”* (“I am a Christian”!)

B. A **MISSIONAL** COMMUNITY DISTINGUISHED BY **GRATITUDE** (vv.11-12)

“And He gave some as apostles, and some as prophets, and some as evangelists, and some as pastors and teachers, for the equipping of the saints for the work of service, to the building up of the body of Christ.” (vv.11-12)

1. He Gave these GIFTS for a redemptive purpose.
2. BUT not only for inward but for outward: *“...and some as evangelists...”*
3. Application: Missions is for Every Believer! (Don’t wait for a call!)

C. A **DISCIPLESHIP** COMMUNITY DIRECTED BY **GODLINESS** (v.13)

“Until we all attain to the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a mature man, to the measure of the stature which belongs to the fullness of Christ.” (v.13)

1. Grasp **God’s Measure** Of “Success” In Ministry: Transformation!
2. Four Marks of Transformation:
 - a. Possible (real); b. Personal (not Proxy); c. Process (not just one-time); d. Person-Bound (Jesus)
3. Story of a Pastor’s Wife (Breakthrough Weekend!)
4. Leonard Ravenhill – Missional: “Not a cruise ship!”
5. What Is The Essential Nature Of A Biblical Community? (Eph 2:19-22)
 - A Community Where You Really Belong (vv.19, 21-22)
 - A Community Where Truth Really Matters (v.20)
 - A Community Where Christ Is Really Honoured (v.20)

Focus. Where Discipleship REALLY Matters

Survey of 15 churches (over 500 respondents) - A Discipled Church!!
