Why Marry?

Someone once said, "If you want to serve God, stay single. If you want to be Christ-like, get married."

It is ironic that many singles desire to be married but some married ones wonder what happened to their dream marriage. Children are also affected by broken marriages — hypocrisy observed by teenagers in their Christian parents' lives and marriages lead to their disappointments and leaving the church. Let's ask a more basic question to all — singles and married — why marry? What is man's purpose? What is God's purpose?

A fairly common response from all is companionship. That's a deep human desire. Yet when two sinners marry, each brings differing ideas of what companionship means. The funny thing is during courtship, things seem to work. At that stage, each one lives out Philipians 2:2-3, "considering not only his own interests but also the interests of others". Then after marriage, career, the need for financial stability, for children's well-being dominate the agenda, and what was done in courtship get squeezed to a nook. Those who intentionally

consider their spouse's interest generally work out better. Yet as sinful individuals, we tend to desire our own interests and preferences. What godly common interests or purposes should married couples have? Is that even in the Bible?

In Genesis 2:15, upon Adam's creation, before Eve's arrival, he was first put in the garden of Eden to work and keep it. Eve was to be a helper fit for Adam. Help him do what? Looking at the context, it is to tend the garden. So there was a common purpose. Of course for us today, we need to translate what it means to "tend the garden". It is probably beyond our job or career, even our family, because the garden of Eden is for everyone, not just for Adam and Eve. It is also a place where the presence of God and fellowship with God is. As a single disciple of God, can you see that purpose for your life? Because that will determine your choice of partner. As a married disciple of God, what is your work in your "garden of Eden" as a couple? Where is the presence of God and fellowship with God in your individual life, in your married life?

Let us take time to review, recalibrate and realign with His purpose!

5. Practise the Remove and Replace Principle.

B. Is Your Love **SACRIFICIAL** or **SELFISH**?

“... and *gave Himself up* for her” (vv.25, 29)

1. “... and *gave Himself up* for her” - Sacrificial Love!

2. Opposite of SACRIFICIAL = SELFISH
- Mark of selfishness? Taking for granted!!
- Start with being sensitive to her needs
- My needs, her needs

3. The story of Dr. Robertson McQuilkin. A Promise Kept.

C. Is Your Love **FAITHFUL** or **FALSE**?

“... *but nourishes* and *cherishes it...*” (v.29)

1. “Nourishes”: Not “critical” and “judgmental”

2. “Cherishes”: Story of Sue Thompson (Husband's Love)

A Word for Husbands Who Have Strayed into AFFAIRS.

Be faithful to your wife – If you have already strayed, REPENT.
