God as a Father

But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us. — Romans 5:8

This verse struck me afresh today regarding how God relates to us as His children, which caused me to reflect on my fathering.

God demonstrates His love. Present tense. He keeps showing His love towards us. I ask myself if I am consistent in loving my kids. Sadly, no. Many times, I say or do things that are not very loving, or even hurting, towards them. God isn't like this one bit towards us. Rather, He keeps showing His perfect love towards us.

God loves us perfectly and unconditionally. Yet, He loved us "while we were still sinners" that is not after we had confessed our sins or repented, not after we had compensated, not because we are perfectly obedient children. It is easy perhaps for a terrible father to love a terrible son if they are both equally terrible. But God is the Perfectly Holy Heavenly Father here and we are unholy,

imperfect children who should be ever faithful and grateful to Him, but are yet completely otherwise. For God to love us unconditionally is completely out of this world. I often find my love towards my children so conditional. I can only keep asking and praying to God to change me to become more like Him in His love for me, so that I might be more like Him in my love towards my children.

In His Perfect Love, God gave us His best — His only Son Jesus. It's easy to love sentimentally. It is difficult to love when the love will cost you most dearly and precious. I had to face this question afresh recently and I found myself struggling. But God did not. He wholly and willingly gave us His best — He gave us His Son Jesus.

As we celebrate Fathers' Day this week, may we celebrate God who is our Perfect Heavenly Father, perfect in His unconditional, sacrificial love for us as His children; and may we consecrate ourselves afresh to becoming like Him as a father towards our children.

THE DISCIPLESHIP OF RADICAL OBEDIENCE

SCRIPTURE: ACTS 5:17-42 • SERMON: REV EDMUND CHAN

Introduction

1. One of the greatest problems in Discipleship today is the lack of congruence: the gap between what we say and what we do. Discipleship is reduced to mere **Knowledge Transfer**.
2. There's no "church" problem. What we have is a **"people"** problem ... with a **"heart"** problem ... an **"obedience"** problem ... a **"faith"** problem ... a **"maturity"** problem ... in essence, a **"discipleship"** problem. *That's the church problem!*

Acts 5 highlights TWO Vital Principles for Discipleship -

A. THE TESTIMONY OF DISCIPLESHIP IS CHANGED LIVES

"... yet here you have filled Jerusalem with your teaching ..." (v.28)

1. Two Dramatic Contrasts -

Contrast 1. From Cowardice To Courage (v.28) – Transformed disciples!!

"... yet here you have filled Jerusalem with your teaching ..." (v.28)

Contrast 2. The Religious Establishment vs The Mighty Apostles Of Jesus (v.17f.)

"But the high priest rose up ... filled with jealousy ... they arrested the apostles ..."

2. **Changed Lives! Why so hard?** Because PRIDE gets in the way!

Application. Is YOUR life changed? How?

B. THE TEST OF DISCIPLESHIP IS OBEDIENCE

"Go and stand in the temple and speak to the people ..." (v.20)

1. **Three Common Problems With Obedience** (the Apostles dealt with them all!)

a. **A Selective Obedience** (I choose to obey what I like and reject what I don't like)

b. **A Partial Obedience**

- Selective Obedience is "Choosing What I Like And What I Don't Like"

- Partial Obedience is "Choosing what God Wants BUT doing it only halfway."

c. **A Delayed Obedience**

v.21 *"And when they heard this, they entered the temple at daybreak..."*

2. **Why Is It So Hard To Obey God And What Can We Do About It? (H.A.R.D.)**

- (1) **Honesty** (*My life is in a Mess*), (2) **Acceptance** (*I can't*),

(3) **Repentance** (*Repent of thinking that I can!*) and (4) **Dependence** (*God Can!*)

3. **The Waywardness Of Stubbornness Or The Wisdom Of Surrender**

[Adapted. Patrick Morley says there are four kinds of Christians]

a. **"I'm Going To Do What I Want**, regardless of what God wants"

b. **"If God Gives Me What I Want**, I would give God what He wants"

c. **"I Will Give God what He wants SO THAT** He would give me what I want."

d. **"I Give God what He wants, REGARDLESS** of what I want, because HE knows what's best for me!" - (*BUT there's a theological flaw in this thinking!*)

Better - "I give God what He wants, REGARDLESS of what I want,

because GOD knows what's best, (not for ME) but **what's best FOR HIS GLORY!**"

Conclusion. Going Forth IN FAITH!
