Building for The Next Generation (2): The Future Unseen

By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to go out to a place that he was to receive as an inheritance. And he went out, not knowing where he was going. (Hebrews 11:8, ESV) Faith is like that — one-part courage and nine-parts obedience!

The Covenant EFC Board has been praying in the light of the church's **domestic growth** and **infrastructural needs** for the coming years. When I (Amos) was asked to lead the Property Committee towards Vision 2028, I was surprised and unsure how I can contribute. However, I accepted this daunting task to “go out to a place” called Vision 2028 and beyond to which God is leading us, because I am inspired and encouraged by Abraham's faith and obedience!

The Lord has been exceedingly gracious to Covenant EFC. All three worship centres have grown significantly. BPJ Centre's first two adult English services are overflowing, WDL Centre's further potential growth is limited only by its insufficient ancillary rooms, and our 20-month old East Centre has grown threefold from its initial pioneer group of 250 worshippers. But there are realities we have to face: All three centres struggle with insufficient space for its weekly Sunbeam and WEB ministries; BPJ and WDL Centres' 30-year HDB **leases will run out in 2027 and 2035** respectively; and Covenant East needs a **permanent “home”**. Yet, Covenant EFC seems poised to grow further with the new Woodlands South MRT Station,

a mere 400-metre walk from our WDL Centre scheduled to open in 2019, while the full Thomson-East Line will be completed by 2024¹; Vision 2028 also envisions **a new fourth worship centre plant** in the greater Jurong West region, which is slated to be the next major population centre in Singapore.

Any statement about the future is a statement of faith. We must see as God sees and do as He has commissioned us. Vision 2028 endeavours to build a strong local IDMC² so as to support a strong global missions arm. We must act now by stewarding our earthly resources to build for the next generation a strong IDMC with multiple centres. And ultimately, to extend the Kingdom of God in Singapore and beyond. That's why the Board and the Senior Pastors are leading Covenant EFC to start raising a **Seed Fund of \$40 million** on our 40th anniversary this year. This fund is earmarked for property acquisitions for Covenant East and West, and to supplement Covenant EFC's ongoing investment funds for BPJ and WDL Centre's lease renewals and development.

Just like Abraham, we trust God to flesh out Vision 2028 as we collectively seek Him. But our mandate is clear: To enlarge His Kingdom in Singapore through Authentic Discipleship and Intentional Disciplemaking of *A Certain Kind* – Vision 2028 is such a God-given vision. May the Lord lead us in this faith journey for His glory!

Last Week's Sermon Summary

A Future Unseen

SCRIPTURE: TOPICAL (THE LIFE OF JOSEPH) • SERMON: SARAH CHAN

Introduction

Joseph had a God-given dream. But even with a dream, his future was unseen.

Our tendency is to see through our human lens: Human lens sees the dream, but misses the person. God sees the person, not just the dream. We see the product, but miss the growth process. God sees the potential which His purpose unfolds. We need to see as God sees.

A. See as God Sees

1. What did God see?
 - a. The Bigger Picture
 - b. The Individual

From a boy who saw the dream as his status (Gen 37), Joseph became a man who saw the dream as God's salvation plan (Gen 45:5-7). He captured God's heart!

2. Joseph grew to see as God sees through:
 - a. His Circumstances – being stripped of everything
 - b. God's Grace – God was Joseph's chief discipler!
3. **Seeing as God sees is about capturing God's heart. Will we disciple the next generation to capture God's heart for salvation?**
4. When we see as God sees, we will desire to do as He says.

B. Do as God Says

1. Secret to a Life of Obedience (Genesis 39 – Story of Joseph and Potiphar's Wife)
 - a. God's pursuit of Joseph is an evidence of God's presence
 - b. Joseph's pursuit of God:
 - i. Fleeing from sin
 - ii. Being faithful in the small things
2. Doing as God says is impossible without God's pursuit of us. That is why Christ came to us! But what is often missing, is our pursuit of Him.
3. **Doing as God says is about cultivating an obedient heart. Will we disciple the next generation to cultivate an obedient heart?**

Conclusion

Joseph's God-given dream was for a higher purpose. It was not just to make him great, but for the salvation of Israel and the nations through them (Gen 50:20). It was through Joseph's lineage, that: Christ **came** to us (1 Tim 1:15), Christ **lives** in us (Eph 1:22-23), and Christ **empowers** His Church to be His discipleship force (Matt 28:18-20)!

Disciplemaking is a privilege He invites us to, not just to keep the next generation in church, but to equip them for His work. Start small. Disciple NOW!
