But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light. – 1 Peter 2:9

One generation shall commend your works to another, and shall declare your mighty acts. – Psalms 145:4

Many of us in Covenant came to know Christ through the evangelistic fervour of the para-churches in the 70s and 80s. The Church in Singapore was not as strong then. We are indeed the recipients of His unmerited saving grace, love and mercy. We also became the beneficiaries of God's blessing on Singapore as the nation progressed from being third world to first world, and our city was transformed from mudflats to metropolis. Collectively, we have enjoyed decades of unprecedented spiritual growth as well as material prosperity.
