Missions Mentoring FAQs



1. **What is the objective of Missions Mentoring?** The missions calling is a unique one that can take years to process. The objective of Missions Mentoring is to intentionally assist members in discerning their full/part time calling in missions, but not year ready to join the 2 year ETC Missions Track. It is a “pre-ETC” programme.
2. **What are the requirements for joining Missions Mentoring?** As it is a key investment of the mentor, priority will be given to applicants who are a member of a small group and a member (or working towards membership) in Covenant. For accountability, we ask all applicants to have an endorsement from their CGL or ZM.
3. **What is the commitment level for Missions Mentoring?** The commitment period is 1 year. Within the year, participants will be asked to take part in four areas of missions development:
 - a. **Mentoring.** Meeting quarterly with a **missions mentor**. Sessions and timings will be agreed upon the mentor and participant after the orientation session. The mentor will facilitate the participant through 4 areas of missions.
 - b. **Serving.** Serving monthly in a **Home Missions** platform. Participants can choose to serve 2-4 hrs/month in a local cross-cultural outreach (befriending international students, serving foreign workers, following-up with new converts, etc.)
 - c. **Leading.** Leading/Assisting in a Covenant **overseas missions trip**. Participants will learn valuable skills in team dynamics and cross-cultural ministry. In consultation with the Missions Department, the participant can choose date, location, and duration.
 - d. **Learning.** Taking the **Foundational Missions Course** during Missions Week. The course is tentatively planned as a 6-8 hr evening course in July, which will be open to the entire church.
4. **How long is the Missions Mentoring programme?** The programme is for one year and will begin in January. After one year, the mentor and participant will assess the readiness of joining ETC or continue the mentoring relationship for another year.
5. **Who will be my missions mentor?** The mission mentor may be a Covenant Staff Member or missions partner of Covenant. The mentor's role is to help process the participant's calling and gifting in the area of missions and to keep connected with the Missions leadership.
6. **How will I know if I have been accepted?** After the closing date on 14 November, applicants will be notified in December and be invited to an orientation date with their mentors on **Sunday, 9 January 2011**.
