

PRAYER HEART

"... for My house will be called a house of prayer for all the peoples."

ISAIAH 56:7

Prayer is essentially communicating to our Father God. This Prayer Heart is a tool to encourage us in our daily communion with Him.



WHY DO WE PRAY?

At the heart of prayer is praying according to the Father's heart. He calls His every child to pray!

In this Prayer Heart, we are learning how to listen to Him, align our hearts with the Lord's and pray His purposes, promises and will in our circumstances. We are seeking His heart when we spend time in personal worship, extended solitude or intercessory prayer for others.

WHAT DO WE PRAY? WE PRAY WITH A ...

HUNGRY HEART FOR GOD

God made us hungry for Him (Ps 84:2). In our prayers, we tell God that we long for Him and we love Him. We tell Him we are grateful to Him and thankful for the things He has done, and what He is going to do for us.

Call to Action: Spending time in personal worship; praying through a Psalm; journaling our thanksgiving.

HOLY HEART FOR SELF

God calls us to be holy as He is holy (1 Pet 1:15–16). Hence, in our prayers, we confess our disobedience to the Lord in our attitudes, behavior and character that

run contrary to what is in His Word. Instead, we tell the Lord we are willing to obey Him in all things, believing that He will transform us through the Holy Spirit (2 Pet 1:3-4).

Call to Action: Ask God to examine our hearts as we go through life situations and in our daily devotions; choose to obey the Lord as He reveals the condition of our hearts.

HELPFUL HEART FOR OTHERS

God has appointed every child of His to pray for others (1 Tim 2:1–4). We ask on their behalf, for God to remove whatever hinders them to receive Jesus as their Saviour and Lord and that they will experience all of God's promises of wholeness and freedom (Lk 4:18–19). Ask God to reveal the specific hindrances and pray God's intended blessings into their lives (1 Jn 5:14–15).

Call to Action: Identify those whom God is directing us to pray for; ask God to reveal their deepest needs; pray according to His Word for God's will to be done; believe that God will do as He says.
