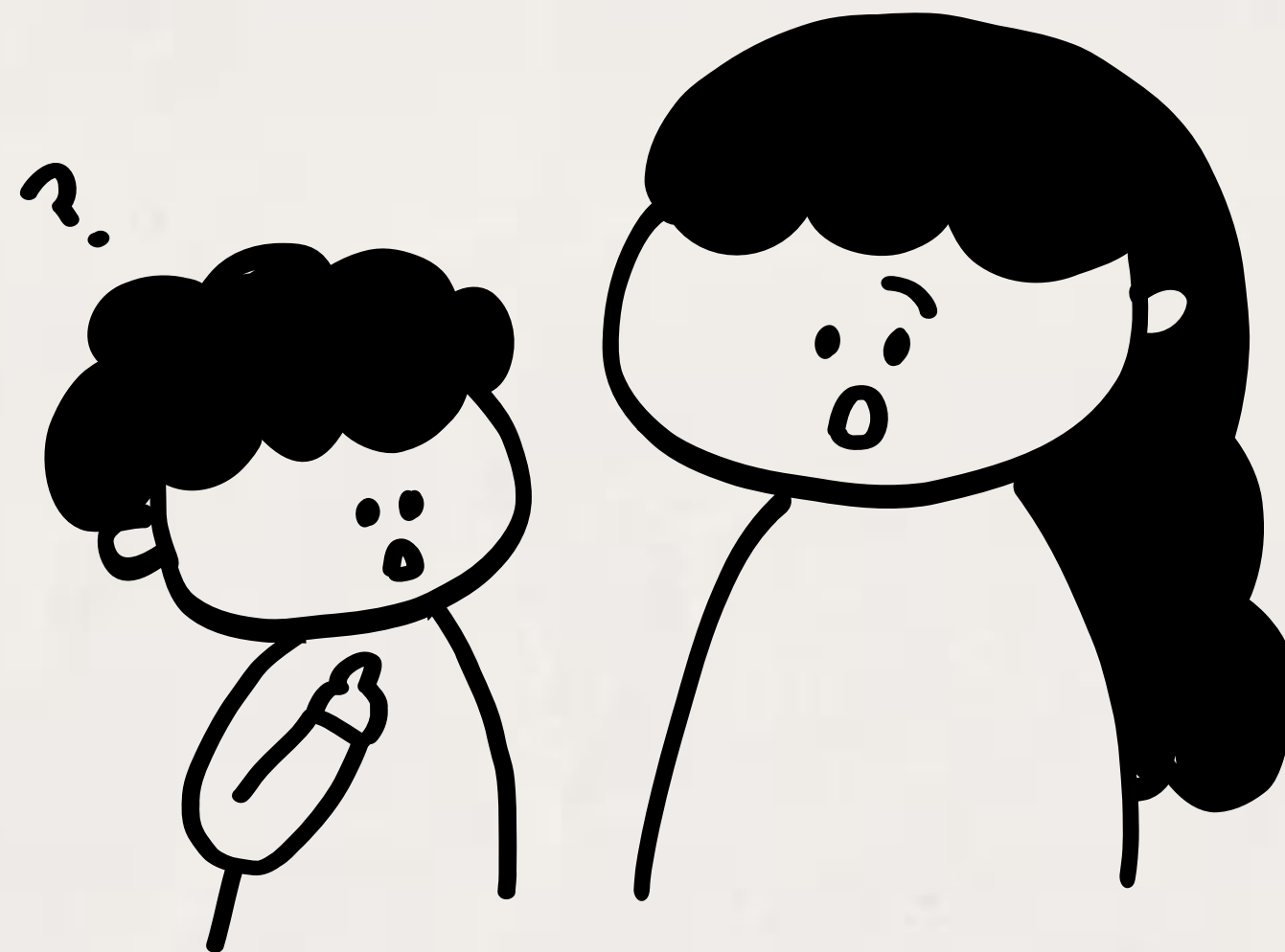


Activity 1: WHO SAY ONE?
